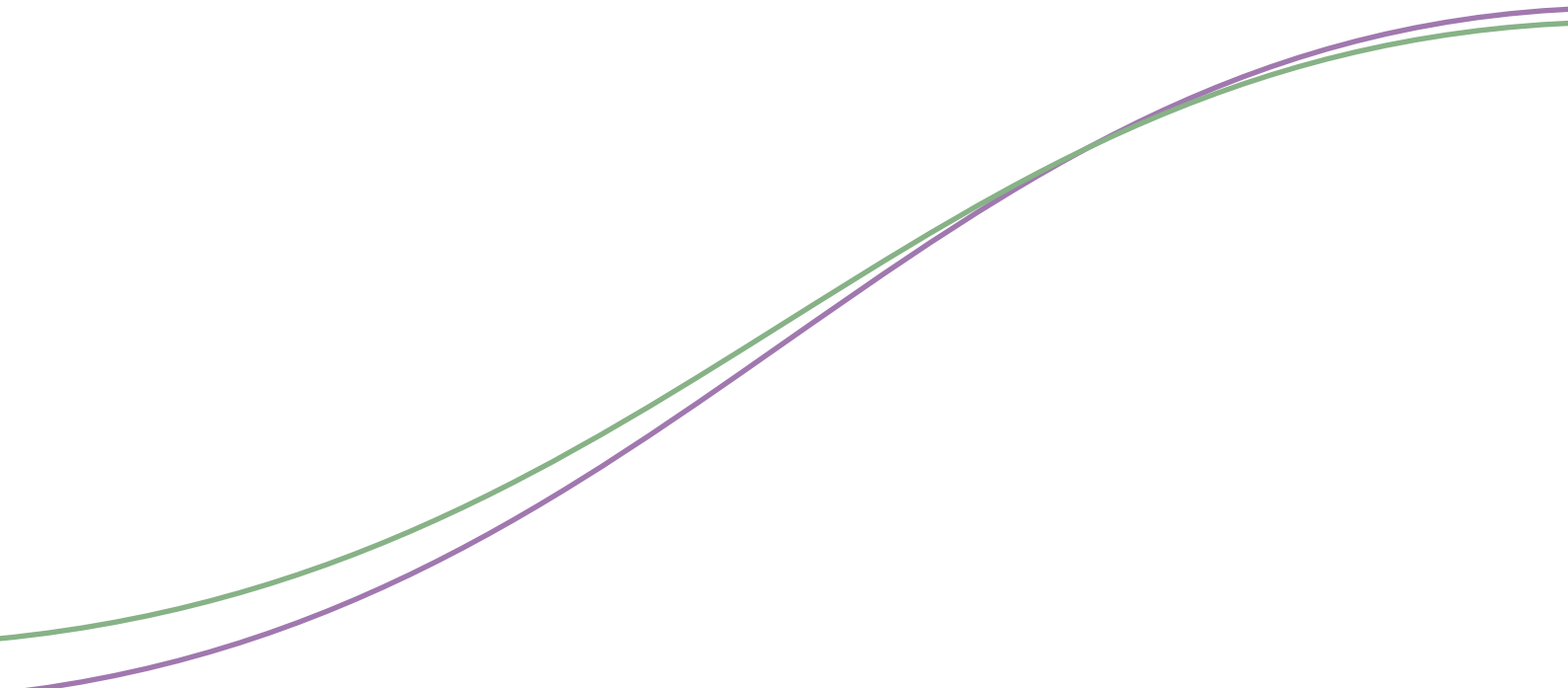




Damage Policy



At Saba Verda International School, we emphasize the importance of responsible behaviour and the care of our school's facilities and equipment. In the event of damage, the following policy is in place:

General Damage:

Deliberate Damages: Any deliberate damage to fixtures, furniture, computers, or laboratory, playground or any school equipment is strictly prohibited. Deliberate damage includes but is not limited to vandalism or misuse of school property.

Accidental Damages: If damage occurs, although accidental but the defaulter has been warned about the possibility of damage, this will be counted as deliberate damage.

Cost of Reparation: In the event of deliberate damage, the defaulter will be held responsible for covering the actual cost of repairing or replacing the damaged equipment or property.

Notification: A formal letter will be issued by the teacher or school authority to notify the student or party responsible for the damage.

Payment: The defaulter is required to make the payment for damages, at the school's office within the stipulated timeframe as mentioned in the notification letter.

We believe that instilling a sense of responsibility and accountability in our students is essential for their personal growth and development. We kindly request the cooperation of all students, staff, and parents in adhering to this policy.
